

Lumberman Dunn Dies In Oregon; Virginia Rites

Funeral services for Abe Dunn, 45, a native and former resident of Macon County who died of a heart attack Nov. 28 near Myrtle Creek, Ore., were held in Virginia.

Mr. Dunn left Macon County two years ago to move to Oregon. He was with the Ritter Lumber Company for about 20 years and was connected with the same firm in Oregon.

His father, Allen Dunn, and brother, Claude, were killed on lumber jobs.

Survivors are his mother, Mrs. E. A. Dunn, of Franklin; his wife; five children; three sisters, Mrs. Joe Jackson, of Franklin, Mrs. Elwood Cabe, of Quantico, Va., and Mrs. Earl Gibson, of Trenton, N. J.; and a brother, Robert, also of Trenton.
