

Mrs. Duvall, 93, Passes In Georgia

Word has been received here of the death of Mrs. Jane Haseltine Duvall, a former Macon county woman, 93 years of age, at the home of her son, Jesse Duvall, near Acworth, Ga.

Mrs. Duvall was preceded in death some years ago by her husband, ~~James A. Duvall~~, a stockman and farmer, also of Macon county, but who had made his home in Georgia for a number of years. She is survived by one son, four daughters, a number of grandchildren, and several great-grandchildren, and numerous relatives in North Carolina, Georgia, Tennessee and other states.

She was the youngest daughter of William Deweese, one of the early settlers of the Burningtown section, and on account of his prowess as a hunter, known to his friends and neighbors as Uncle Buck. She was a granddaughter of the Rev. Garrett Deweese, a pioneer Baptist preacher of the Big Ivy section of Buncombe county, and the last known living member of her generation.
