

Rev. L. W. Duvall Passes In Clayton, Ga.

The Rev. L. W. Duvall, 74, widely known in Macon county, died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. James L. Smith, in Clayton, Ga., on Thursday, April 21.

Mr. Duvall, widely known here as "Uncle Bert" was born on lower Burningtown and was the son of the late Calvin and Nancy Killian Duvall.

Mr. Duvall, a Baptist minister, who received his education at the Hiwassee Institute, had served the Baptist churches in Towns and Rabun counties in Georgia for the past 40 years, and death came while he was sitting by the radio listening to a program.

The only close survivor in Macon county is a sister, Mrs. Emma Woody, of Tellico, and a number of cousins and close friends.
