## Mrs. Canty Edwards Dies In Atlanta, Ga.

Mrs. Canty T. Picklesimer Edwards, widow of Fred A. Edwards, died January 25 in an Atlanta, Ga., hospital following an extended illness. She was 60.

Mrs. Edwards was a native of Jackson County and moved to Franklin when she was 17. Mr. and Mrs. Edwards operated a general merchandise store in Highlands. Mrs. Edwards retired in 1954 after 37 years.
