Edd Frank Edwards, 73, of the Horse Cove Community, Highlands, died unexpectedly of an apparent heart attack Monday night in a Summerville, S. C. hospital.

The son of the late Alex and Alpha Speed Edwards, he had been a rancher in Douglas, Wyo until his retirement in the early 1950's. He was a veteran of World War I and a member of the Blue Ridge Lodge No. 435, AF & AM.

Funeral services will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday in the Highlands United Methodist Church, of which he was a member.
