

## J. B. Elmore Passes At 87

John Baxter Elmore, a carpenter and mason of the Co-wee community, died Wednesday, November 24, at the age of 87. He had been in declining health for several years.

Funeral services for Mr. Elmore, a native of this county, were conducted the 26th at 2:30 p.m. at the Snow Hill Methodist Church by the Rev. Joseph Phillips, pastor, and the Rev. C. C. Welch.
