Booker T. England Dies As Result Of Stab Wound

Booker T. England, 30-year-old negro, died Sunday night as the result of a knife wound said to have been inflicted by Lucile Conley, 16-year-old negro girl.

England is said to have gone to the Conley home for the purpose of taking the girl for a ride with him, and it is alleged that he became angered when the girl's mother refused to let her go with him, and became very abusive. People who were near by at the time said that England had a knife and a stone he had picked up, and that the girl secured a knife in the house. The battle occurred in the road near the house, and England received a wound which penetrated his heart.

The girl was placed in jail pending a hearing which was called for Wednesday afternoon, but was postponed upon request of the prosecution until Friday, August 5, at 10 a. m.

The girl was later released under \$1,000 bond.

Funeral services for England were held Monday afternoon at the Sugarfork cemetery.
