

## Ralph A. Felices

*Native of Puerto Rico, U.S. Army veteran of WWII*

Ralph A. Felices, 84, of Franklin, died Tuesday, Aug. 12, 2003, in a local nursing home.



A native of Puerto Rico, he was the son of the late Jorge Felices and Julia Rosa Pietrantonio. He was a U.S. Army veteran of World War II and was a member of the American Legion Post 108 and the VFW Post 7339. He was a past member of Desi Arnaz Orchestra from 1945-1949, was involved in the manufacturing of Dialysis Machines with Milton Royal Corp. in St. Petersburg, Fla., worked as a correctional counselor for the Dept. of Offender Rehabilitation Region 4 in Miami, Fla., for eight years and worked for Fitzgerald Casino in Reno, Nev., before retiring in 1982. He moved to Franklin in 1984.

He is survived by five children, Ralph A. Felices Jr. of Las Vegas, Nev., William Dennis Felices of Reno, Angelique Carter of St. Petersburg, Fla., Milan Thomas of Sweden, Celeste Zoe of Minneapolis, Minn., and several grandchildren.
