

Clement Ferraro, 86, formerly of Macon County, died Wednesday, April 16, 2008, at Silver Bluff Nursing Home of Canton.

A native of New York, he was a son of the late Salvatore and Eleanora Ferraro. He was also preceded in death by a sister, Phyllis Concilvio; and a brother, Salvatore Ferraro Jr.
