

Mrs. Janie Fox, 94 Taken By Death

Mrs. Janie Adams Fox, 94, died Saturday night at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Mattie Moss, at Gneiss after a two-weeks' illness following a paralytic stroke.

Funeral services were held at 3 o'clock Sunday afternoon at the Mountain Grove Baptist church, of which she was a member, by the Rev. J. I. Vinsbn. Burial was in the church cemetery.

Pallbearers were Lyman and Zeb Moss, James and John Taylor, Walter Young and Henry Fox.

Mrs. Fox, widow of William Fox, a Confederate veteran, was born in the Ellijay community and had lived in Macon county all her life.

Surviving are three daughters, Mrs. Lydia Adams of Ellijay township; Mrs. Peggy Gregory of Ringgold, Va.; and Mrs. Moss, and a son, T. L. Fox of Hiddenite.
