### Funeral Held Monday Afternoon at Baptist Church

Mrs. Ellen Rich Franks, 71, died at her home on Main street Sunday night after an illness of several months.

Funeral services were held at the Franklin Baptist church Monday afternoon at 3 o'clock with the Rev. Eugene R. Eller, pastor, in charge.
