

Frank E. Frye Dies In Bryson City

Frank Ennett Frye, retired hotel operator and lumberman, died at his home in Bryson City Sunday night after an unexpected heart attack suffered Saturday afternoon.

Mr. Frye was the father of Mrs. Louise Conan, of Franklin, and besides Mrs. Conan is survived by his wife and four sons, Robert and Frank E. Frye, Jr., of Murphy, Harold Frye of Waynesville, and William Frye of Enka, and two other daughters, Mrs. T. J. Sandlin, Jr., of Bryson City, and Mrs.

Catherine Cope of Enka.

Mr. Frye moved to Bryson City from Mount Victory, Ohio, and had lived in that section ever since. He was at one time operator of Fryemont Inn and in recent years had operated the Entella hotel.

Mr. Frye married Miss Mattie Pender of Bryson City shortly after coming to Western North Carolina. He was a veteran of the Spanish-American war and was a Mason and a Shriner.
