Word has been received here by E. B. and O. H. Gay of the death of their brother, Clarence M. Gay, 69, in Orlando, Fla., on June 26.

Mr. Gay was an outstanding civic leader and was widely known and highly respected in banking circles throughout Florida. His banking career began at an early age and he had held a number of responsible positions in the field, including that of State Comptroller of Florida. At the time of his death he was paid high tribute by his colleagues and by many state officials including Florida State Governor Reubin Askew.
