

Funeral Services For H. M. Gibson

Funeral services for Hiram Millard Gibson, 80, were held on Tuesday afternoon at the Holly Springs Baptist church. The Rev. Mr. Triplett, pastor, was in charge of the services. Interment was in the Holly Springs cemetery.

Mr. Gibson, a well-known farmer, died at his home in the Holly Springs community on Monday morning at 2:30 o'clock following an illness of several months.

A son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Walter Gibson, he was born on January 4, 1860, in Macon county, where he has spent his life. On August 10, 1889, he was married to Miss Elizabeth Passmore, also of this county. He was a member of the Watauga Baptist church.

Surviving are three sons, Thomas, Phillip and James Gibson, all of Macon county; one sister, Miss Polly Gibson, one brother, Phillip Gibson, of Norton, Ga.; five half-brothers, James, John, Leach, Frank and Noah Gibson, and two half-sisters, Mary and Anna Gibson.
