

## Ernest Gragg

Ernest L. Gragg, 81, of Varnes Road in Lakemont, died Saturday, March 10, 2001 in Stephens County Hospital in Toccoa.

Born in Rabun County, he was the son of the late Elijah L. and Missouri Shedd Gragg. He was a farmer and a U.S. Army veteran of World War II.
