

# DEATH CLAIMS JESSE C. GRANT

Widely Known Citizen Of  
County Passes At  
Age Of 92

Jesse Calvin Grant, 92, well-known Macon county citizen, died at his home Saturday morning after an illness of 14 months.

Mr. Grant for many years operated, in several sections of the county, a burr mill. In his latter active years he was a farmer. Until he was taken sick last year, he had the reputation of never having taken a dose of medicine. He was known all over the county and was highly esteemed for his high character and good citizenship.

Surviving Mr. Grant are his second wife, the former Miss Ella Boston, and eight children. Four of the children, James Grant of Waynesville, Mrs. Rosie Wood of Hindale, Mrs. Dora Clark of Rutherfordton and Mrs. Oddie Ford of Waynesville, are of his first marriage to the former Miss Sarah Queen. The other four are Fred and Elijah Grant of Franklin, Mrs. Dewey Cunningham of Hickory Knoll and Mrs. Carl Bingham of Murphy.

Funeral rites were conducted at 3 o'clock Sunday afternoon at the Franklin Baptist church by the Rev. C. F. Rogers, pastor, and burial was in the Franklin cemetery.
