

# M. C. GRASTY, 52 PASSES MONDAY

Funeral Held at Bethel  
Methodist Church  
Tuesday

M. C. Grasty, 52, died Monday morning at 7:30 at his home on Bonny Crest, following two strokes of paralysis, one last Thursday evening and another Sunday night.

Funeral services were conducted at the Bethel Methodist church Tuesday morning at 10 o'clock by Rev. J. J. Edwards, pastor, assisted by Rev. A. A. Angel. A solo, "Home of the Soul," was sung by Mrs. J. A. Flanagan.
