

## Funeral Held

### Mrs. W. H. Green Dies After Long Illness

Mrs. W. H. Green died at her home in the Patton settlement at noon Monday at the age of 55 years and seven months. She had been an invalid since suffering a stroke of paralysis three years ago. Monday morning she suffered another stroke and death came in the middle of the day.
