

DEATH TAKES MRS. GREEN

**Haywood Native
Has 93 Descendants;
Louisa Chapel Rites**

Mrs. Nannie E. Green, whose descendants number 93, including 10 children, died Saturday at 9:35 a. m. at the home of a daughter, Mrs. Ernest Wallace, and Mr. Wallace, in the Carson community.

She had been ill for about three months. Mrs. Green was 84.

A native of Haywood County, she was a daughter of William and Mrs. Louisa Snyder Sellers, born May 5, 1873. On April 3, 1891, she married Samuel S. Green. He died Jan. 1, 1931.

Mrs. Green was a member of Louisa Chapel Methodist Church and at one time taught Sunday School there.
