

W. H. GREENE, 75, DIES TUESDAY

Services Held Wednesday At Louisa Methodist Church

William Hayes Greene, 75, a native of Haywood county, died Tuesday night in a local hospital after a brief illness. Mr. Green had been a resident of the Cartoogechayo section of this county for the past 40 years and was active with the Republican party here.

Funeral services were held yesterday (Wednesday) afternoon at 3 o'clock at the Louisa Methodist church. The Rev. C. L. Grant, the Rev. A. W. Potts, and the Rev. C. C. Welch officiated. Burial was in the church cemetery.

Mr. Greene was born in Haywood county December 14, 1876, the son of Thaddeus and Louisa Shook Greene. He was a member of the Louisa Methodist church. In 1898 he was married to Miss Hester Sellers, who died in 1933.
