

G. A. Gribble Killed In Railroad Accident

G. A. Gribble, 30, son of Mrs. W. A. Gribble of Prentiss, was killed in a railroad accident near his home at Aberdeen, Wash., on April 21, according to a telegram received by relatives. Mr. Gribble was a brakeman on the train on which the accident occurred.

The deceased left Franklin 10 years ago for the West. He is survived by his widow, a native of Seattle, Wash. Interment was at Aberdeen. Mr. Gribble was a World war veteran, having served with the 28th Division of the Pennsylvania National Guard. He was a member of the Elk fraternity.
