

J. C. Guest Dies At Franklin Home

J. C. Guest, 67, died at his home near Franklin on May 2 following a period of illness. Funeral services were held at the Watauga Baptist church and interment was in the cemetery of the church. Services were conducted by Rev. A. S. Solesbee, aided by Rev. Dr. W. E. Abernethy.

Mr. Guest had been a valued employe of the Knoxville Power company at Calderwood, Tenn. Officials of this company sent a letter of sympathy to the widow of the deceased along with a check to help cover funeral expenses.

Besides his widow, Mr. Guest is survived by four sons, Fred, Jim, George and Charles, of Franklin, and by one daughter, Mrs. Mary Yeoman, of Franklin.
