

### **Mr. Guthrie**

Glynn E. Guthrie, Sr., 73, of East Palatka, Fla., previously of Franklin, died Thursday, Aug. 8, at Hadlow House Nursing Center in Jacksonville, Fla., following a brief illness. He was born in Green Cove Springs, Fla., and had been living there for the past 10 years.

He was a U.S. Army veteran having served in the Korean Conflict. He retired from the Florida Highway Patrol as a captain in 1983 following 32 years of service.
