

**Fred L. Hall, 55,  
Of Macon County  
Passes Suddenly**

Fred L. Hall, 55, died of a heart attack while working at his home in the Ellijay section of Macon county Wednesday afternoon.

A native of Haywood county, Mr. Hall was a son of LaFate Hall and Josephine Blalock Hall. He was employed by the Farmers' Federation at Canton until about seven years ago when he moved to Macon county. He had been engaged in farming since that time. He was a conference member of the Seventh Day Adventist church at Charlotte.

Funeral services were held on Friday afternoon, at 2:30 o'clock at Bethel Methodist church, Rev. L. T. Knetch, Rev. J. L. Stokes and Rev. C. W. Judy officiating. Burial was in the Bethel cemetery.
