

Dies From Gunshot Wound In Shoulder

John Hance, 24, of Willets, died in Angel hospital Tuesday morning at 7:15.

On Friday, August 27, while shooting crows, the shotgun that he was using was accidentally discharged with the entire load going into his left shoulder, at the pit of the arm.

Death was caused from a hemorrhage. He had been given several blood transfusions.

He was the son of Walter Hance, where the body was taken Tuesday morning.
