Pfc. Walter W. Hannah, son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred L. Hannah, of Franklin route 1, and Washington, D. C., who was killed in action in France in October 1944. Pfc. Hannah, who was serving in the infantry unit, entered the service in November 1943 and took his basic training at Fort George Meade, Md.
