Albert Stockton Happoldt, 82, of Highlands, died Saturday, Oct. 25, in a Highlands-Cashiers hospital.

A Charlotte native, he was the son of the late Fred Alexander and Louise Baldwin Happoldt. He graduated from Georgia Tech and was general manager of the Atlanta Athletic Club and East Lake Country Club from 1928 until 1945.

Happoldt was president, chairman of the board and manager of Highlands Country Club from 1945 until 1980. Services were held at 4 p.m. Tuesday in Highlands First Presbyterian Church.

The Revs. Daniel McCall and Ron Botsford officiated. Burial was at 2 p.m. Wednesday in Decatur Cemetery in Decatur.
