

**MRS. HELEN C. HARDY  
PASSES IN WELLESLEY, MASS.**

Word was received here Friday of the death of Mrs. Helen Cobb Hardy at the home of her son, Dr. Arthur C. Hardy, in Wellesley, Mass.

Mrs. Hardy was a sister of Mrs. T. G. Harbison, Mrs. A. C. Holt and Richard J. Cobb of Highlands. She and her late husband were citizens of Berkeley, Calif., for many years. Since Mr. Hardy's death a few years ago she had made her home in Wellesley with her son, Dr. Arthur Cobb Hardy, who is professor of physics at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, and also holds a position in the camouflage department of war work in Washington, where his knowledge as a pioneer in technicolor is proving most valuable.

In addition to her son, Mrs. Hardy is survived by four grandchildren.
