

**PFC. JOHN G. HAUSER**

Pfc. John G. Hauser was killed in action in France on September 17, according to word received here by his mother, Mrs. Betty A. Hauser of Franklin. Pfc. Hauser was 36 years old, the son of the late Luther W. Hauser.

He entered service in May, 1942 and took training at Camp Wheeler, Macon, Ga., and Camp Blanding, Fla. In October, 1942, the infantry unit with which he served landed in England and he went to France on the first day of the invasion of the Brittany coast.

Before entering the service, Pfc. Hauser was employed by the Bryant Funeral Home and Furniture Co. for ten years.

He is survived by his mother, four brothers, Quince, James H., of Franklin, Milton, of Winston-Salem, and William, with the infantry somewhere in France.
