

NINE MACON MEN WAR CASUALTIES

Two Missing, One Killed, Nine Wounded Overseas

S1/c George W. Hayes, negro, U.S. Navy, son of Mrs. Mary Hayes, was killed in an explosion which took place last week in San Francisco harbor, California.

Seaman Hayes is a graduate of the negro high school and attended a welding school in eastern Carolina. Before entering the service he worked in a shipyard at Smithport, Va. He was 20 years old.

He is survived by his mother, a sister, Virginia Bryson of Franklin, grandparents, Jenny and George Hayes, and uncle, Wiley Hayes.
