

MRS. HENDERSON DIES THURSDAY

Was 83 Years of Age; Had
Been Living in Macon
County 40 Years

Mrs. Molly Aiken Henderson, 84, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Maxine Sprinkles, on Franklin Route 2, on Thursday of the past week. Death was caused from paralysis and came very suddenly.

Funeral services were held at the home Friday afternoon at 3 o'clock. The Rev. J. C. Swain, pastor of the Union church and the Rev. Guy Bowers, pastor of the Church of God, were in charge of the services. Interment was in the Union cemetery.

Mrs. Henderson was a daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. John Aiken, of Brevard. She was the widow of the late C. F. Henderson and moved to this county from Brevard 40 years ago. She joined the Methodist church in Greenville, S. C., at the age of 12 years and in June, 1933, joined the Church of God.
