

MRS. J. S. HENRY LAID TO REST

Funeral Held Tuesday For Holly Springs Woman

Mrs. Elmira Henry, 91 years old, died at her home at Holly Springs Monday morning at 7 o'clock after an illness of several years, and was buried at the Holly Springs Baptist church Tuesday morning at 11 o'clock with the Rev. A. S. Solesbee conducting the funeral.

Mrs. Henry was the daughter of J. D. and Sallie Franks and was born in Cherokee county in 1840 and moved to this county in early childhood. She was married to John S. Henry in 1865. Mr. Henry died about fifteen years ago.

The deceased was the oldest member of the Franklin Baptist church, having joined in 1864, and lived a very consecrated life. She was well known and highly esteemed throughout the county.

Mrs. Henry is survived by one sister, Mrs. Lizzie Wildes, of Burningtown, and several nieces and nephews.
