

Noah Henry Succumbs At Age Of 78

Noah Love Henry, farmer and native of Macon County, died Saturday, July 19, at his home on Franklin, Route 2 (Trenton section). Seventy-eight, he had been ill for 10 months.

Funeral services for Mr. Henry were held Monday afternoon at Dryman's Chapel Methodist Church, of which he was a member. Officiating was the Rev. R. L. Pondexter. Burial was in the church cemetery.

Born June 11, 1880, he was the son of James and Mrs. Delilah Jones Henry. He had been married twice, first to Miss Hulda Talley, who died in 1916, and then to Miss Florence Justice.
