

Death Takes Mrs. Henry

Mrs. Vera Josephine Hudson Henry, a former school teacher and owner of Henry's Court in Franklin for the past 24 years, died Friday, August 30, at 11:15 p.m. at Angel Hospital. She was 72, and had been ill for two weeks.

Mrs. Henry was the widow of John B. Henry, of this county, who died in 1938. She was active in the First Baptist Church, had been a Sunday school teacher, and was a member of the W.M.U. She attended Asheville Normal Teachers College and taught school for some 20 years.

Funeral services were held

September 1 at 2 p.m., at the First Baptist Church by the Rev. R. R. Standley, pastor, and burial was in the Woodlawn Cemetery. Serving as pallbearers were Dr. C. G. Walker, Walter Dean, Roy Rickman, Elbert Angel, Hunter Calloway, and Herbert Angel.
