Mrs. Cumi Henson Dies December 4 At Home

Mrs. Cumi Liner Henson, of Franklin, widow of George R. Henson, died Wednesday, December 4, at 1 a.m. at her home. She was 85 and had been in declining health for some time.

Funeral services for Mrs. Henson were conducted the 5th at 2:30 p.m. at the First Methodist Church, of which she was a member, by the Rev. J. P. Hornbuckle, Jr., the Rev. Garland Young, and the Rev.
