

## E. B. HENSON DIES MAY 1

Passes At Home  
Of Son; Rites  
Conducted Here

Funeral services for Eli Brad-son Henson, 82-year-old native of this county who died May 1 in Waynesville at the home of his son, Jess Henson, were conducted May 3 at the Prentiss Baptist Church.

Officiating were the Rev. F. R. Layell, pastor, and the Rev. R. L. Poindexter. Burial was in the Pleasant Hill Cemetery.

A farmer, Mr. Henson had been ill only a short time.
