

### Services For Mrs. Henson At Mulberry Wednesday

Final rites for Mrs. Gertrude Norton Henson, 20, were held on Wednesday afternoon at 3 o'clock at the Mulberry Baptist church. The Rev. Lester Sorrells, Rev. George A. Cloer, Rev. Frank Reid and the Rev. J. C. Swain, were in charge of the services. Interment was in the church cemetery.
