Taken By Death At Her Home Near Franklin

Mrs. Lucille Henson, 68, wife of James D. Henson, died at their home, Franklin, Route 3, Tuesday morning at 11:45 o'clock, following an illness of two months. The funeral services were held on Wednesday afternoon at 3 o'clock at the Tellico Baptist church. The Rev. Judson Smith, pastor, officiated, and burial followed in the church cemetery.
