

MACK HIGDON SUCCUMBS IN MORGANTON

**Was Jackson Native;
Lived On Route 3;
Rites Held Monday**

Mack McDowell Higdon, 73 farmer of Franklin, Route 3, died Saturday (Dec. 8) in Morganton. A native of Jackson County, he had been in declining health for five years.

Funeral services were conducted Monday at 11 a. m. at the Zion Hill Baptist Church in Jackson County, of which he was a member. The Rev. Joe Bishop officiated and burial was in the church cemetery.

Born February 8, 1883, Mr. Higdon was the son of Mr. and Mrs. Lee Andrew Higdon. In 1914 he was married to Miss Cordella Lauder milk, of this county, who died April 15, 1944.

He is survived by three sons, Howard Higdon, of Franklin, Route 3, William Lee Higdon, of Sylva, Route 2, and James R. Higdon, of Louisville, Ky.; a daughter, Mrs. W. H. McCartha, of Columbia, S. C.; and 10 grandchildren.
