

### **Mrs. Margaret Berry Higdon, 93, Passes**

Mrs. Margaret Berry Higdon, 93, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Eva C. Keener, at Higdonville, Saturday morning. Although she had been ill for the past seven years, death was the result of a stroke of apoplexy suffered on Tuesday afternoon.

Mrs. Higdon, a life-long resident and widely-known citizen, was born July 30, 1847. She was a daughter of the late Logan A. and Matilda Postell Berry. She was married to Joseph H. Higdon, who preceded her in death a number of years ago. She was a member of the Sugarfork church.

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. G. W. Davis, pastor, officiated, assisted by Rev. C. F. Rogers, pastor of the Franklin Baptist church. Interment in the Church cemetery.
