

Highlands Man Is Drowned In Fall From Boat

Highlands, Sept. 3—Caught in the swirling waters of the Cullasaja river, near here, and dashed against the sharp rocks that jut out of the water along the bed of the fast-flowing mountain stream, Hoyte Hill, 23-year-old, of near Highlands, was drowned Saturday afternoon.

On a fishing trip, Hill attempted to cross the river on a raft, it was said, when he fell into the water, and was unable to reach safety. The water caught him and drew him under the rocks, witnesses said.

Hill, who was formerly a traveling salesman for a Knoxville, Tenn., candy concern, was the son of Thomas H. Hill, of near Highlands.

Funeral services were held Sunday at Horse Cove near here.—Asheville Times.
