

O. V. Hill Victim Of Auto Accident

Funeral services for O. V. Hill, 63, of Canton, who was struck by an automobile two weeks previous, and who died of injuries received, were held at the Canton Presbyterian church last Thursday afternoon, with burial at the Bon-A-Venture cemetery.

Mr. Hill was a native of Macon county and was well known here. He had been an employee of the Champlon Paper and Fibre company since 1932.
