## Formerly Of Highlands Passes March 28

James N. Holland, 44, died last Thursday afternoon, March 28, in Angel hospital following an illness of several months. Death was caused from inflammatory rheumatism and complications.

Mr. Holland, a World War veteran, was the son of the late William L. and Ellen Rogers Holland of Highlands. He was born at Highlands and spent his early life there. Since 1915 he had been living at Homer, Ga., where he was engaged in farming and other activities.

The funeral services were held at 4 o'clock Friday afternoon at the Sugarfork Baptist church, seven miles from Franklin on the Franklin-Highlands highway. The Rev. J. G. Benfield, pastor of the Highlands Baptist church, officiated and burial was in the Sugarfork cemetery.

Pallbearers were Sam Stanfield and S. H. Crunkleton of Franklin; Will Rogers, of Oneiss, and Denver Holland, William Steyman and Clyde Crisp, of Cullasaga.

Surviving are one sister, Miss Rosie Holland of Highlands, and one half-brother, S. S. Holland of Glenville, Jackson county.
