

Martha Serrao 'Marcie' Holly, of Tiger, Ga., formerly of Franklin, passed away on Sunday, Oct. 21, 2007.

Lovingly known as Marcie, she was born in Rutherford, N.J., on Christmas Day, 1923, to Frances Serrao and Martha Stock Serrao.
