

## Mrs. Horne Passes. At Home In Bethel

Funeral services for Mrs. Nannie Fulton Horne, 71, were held at the Bethel Methodist church Sunday afternoon, December 28. The Rev. Philip L. Green, pastor, officiated, assisted by John T. Jennings. Interment was in the church cemetery.

Mrs. Horne died at her home in the Bethel community Sunday morning at 5:45 o'clock following an 18 months' illness.

A daughter of the late R. L. and Caroline Sanders Fulton, Mrs. Horne was born November 22, 1870, and was a life-long resident of Macon county. On January 1, 1891, she was married to Edwin F. Horne, of the Bethel community, who died a few years ago. She was a member of Bethel Methodist church and took an active interest in the woman's missionary society of that church as long as her health would permit.
