

Geo. Howard, 81, Passes In Mulberry, Section

Final rites for George Howard, 81, were held at the Mulberry Methodist church on Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock. The Rev. J. C. Smith, pastor, was in charge of the services. Burial was in the Mulberry cemetery.

Mr. Howard, a farmer and well-known citizen of Macon county, died at his home in the Mulberry community on Sunday morning at 2:30 o'clock, following a lingering illness of one year.

A life-long resident of this county, Mr. Howard was born on October 18, 1858. He was a son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Paluski Howard. On February 4, 1883 he was married to Miss Nancy Hemp-hill, who preceded him in death a number of years ago. He was a member of the Mulberry Methodist church.
