

Dies Of Heart

Attack While On Trip Through Smokies

Chester Huffman, of Shreveport, La., brother-in-law of Miss Daisy Caldwell, Macon County home supervisor for the Farm Security administration, died of a heart attack last Friday afternoon while on a trip through the Great Smoky Mountains National park.

Mr. Huffman, who was stricken about 1 p. m., died within a short time. He apparently had been in good health.

He and Mrs. Huffman and their son, King, came to Franklin last week for a visit to Miss Caldwell, and Friday morning the four left for the trip through the Smokies.

The body was taken to McKenzie, Tenn., for funeral services and interment.
