

Walter Hunnicutt, 71, Dies at Tallulah Falls

Mr. Walter Hunnicutt, 71, photographer, of Tallulah Falls, Ga., died Tuesday afternoon at 6 o'clock, while on his way home from his studio, where he had spent the day. Death was attributed from a sudden heart attack. He had been in ill health for a year or more, but was able to be up and look after his business. He operated one of the oldest established businesses in Rabun county, Ga., which was known as Hunnicutt's studio.

He leaves a widow and several children and grandchildren. He was the father of William Hunnicutt, who is an employee of the Tallulah Falls railway at Franklin, and a brother of Mr. E. S. Hunnicutt, of this place.

Funeral services were held at the Methodist church at Tallulah Falls at 2 o'clock Wednesday afternoon.
