

Funeral Rites For George B. Hurst

Funeral services for George Bascom Hurst, 67, were held Saturday morning at 10 o'clock at the Cowee Baptist church, five miles north of Franklin on the Bryson City highway. The Rev. R. F. Mayberry, pastor, was in charge of the services. Interment was in the church cemetery.

Mr. Hurst, a well-known citizen of Macon county, died at his home near Iotla Bridge, Thursday night at 8 o'clock following an illness of two years. Death was due to rheumatism and complications.

Mr. Hurst, the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Matt Hurst, was born and reared in Macon county. On January 7, 1912, he was married to Miss Arie Tippet, of the Iotla community. He was a farmer.
