

Last Rites For Mrs. R. R. Jacobs

Mrs. Rachel Rebecca Jacobs, 81, widow of Jule Jacobs, died at her home on Green street here at 5 o'clock Saturday morning. She had been seriously ill one week and in ill health three years. Death was caused by pneumonia.
